Reg. 1 Organisation

The 2017 FIM-Rally is organised by: Sundsvall Motor Cycle Club (hereafter known as SMCC) On the behalf of the Fédération Internationale de Motorcyclisme (FIM) and the Touring and Leisure Commission (CTL), the event will be held from 26th of July 2017 to 29th of July 2017 according to the FIM Code for Tourist Gatherings (hereafter known as CTG) – FIM-Rally section: to the rules of the FIM, to these Supplementary Regulations (SR) and to the FIM Environmental Code.

Reg. 2 Participation in the FIM-Rally

According to the FIM Code for Touristic Gatherings (Rally Art 2 & 4)

Reg. 3 Entries

Reg. 3.1 - Individual entries will be made on the form available for this purpose (or the duplicate) which will be delivered to the FNMs by the Organiser (CTC Rally Art 5). The FNMs will return the entry forms to the Organiser after verification (see address in Reg. 1.1).

Reg. 3.2 - The FNMs will also add a summary list (excel sheet (s), provided by CTL) containing the following information:

- Name of participants
- The sum paid for the entry fees and accommodation (hotel and camping)
- The names and addresses of the participants' motorcycle clubs
- The distance from the headquarters of the club to the Rally centre.
- The name, licence number and e-mail address of the National Delegate (s)

Reg. 4 Entry fee

The entry fee is fixed by the Federation of the participant. This is composed of the organiser's fee 185 € plus any administrative expenses which may be added by the FNM.

The amount is fixed in Euro (€). The transfer costs are to be paid by the expeditor.

The FIM-Rally is free of charge for children under 8 years old. Children between 8 and 12 years benefit from a discount of 50%. The entry fee will be paid in full (100%) by the FNMs of the participant before 15th of April 2017 to the following account:

Reg. 5 Closing date for entries

The deadline for entries and booking of the accommodation is the 15th of April. Booking after this date an additional costs will be charged with + 25% of registration and accommodation fees.

Reg. 6 Gifts, souvenirs and services for the participants

Every participant who has paid the registration fee receives the following benefits:

- A bag containing souvenir gift (s) and medal or plaque
- Excursion(s) in the vicinity
- An entertainment programme
- Three (3) evening meals, one (1) lunch served at restaurant and one (1) picnic (CTG Rally Art. 6)

Reg. 7 Accommodation

The hotel or camping bookings will be made on the “accommodation” booking form. The amounts due for the accommodation will be paid at the same time as the registration fee, i.e. before 15th of April 2017 to the bank account quoted in Reg.4. All payments will be in Euros (€) and will cover the transfer costs.

- 100% of the campsite booking fee will be paid with the registration.
- 100% of the hotel booking fee will be paid with the registration.

Reg. 8 Optional Excursions

Bookings for these optional excursions must be made at the same time as the registration on the special form provided.

These optional excursions are also to be paid before 15th of April 2017

Reg. 9 Welcome Centre

The Welcome Centre will be open on 23th of July 2017 to 29th of July 2017

The entry papers of the participants will be checked at the Welcome Centre upon arrival. The FIM Meritum and Co-Meritum stamps will also be distributed at this time. Participants will receive a "classification card" similar to their ID card which **MUST** be handed over at the Arrival Control, In order to be classified as participant of the rally.

Reg. 10 Arrival Control

The Arrival Control will be operational on 26th of July 2017 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM at the centre of Sundsvall. In order to be classified, participants must hand over the "classification card" distributed earlier at the Welcome Centre. Neither copies nor the original entry forms will be accepted or counted for the classification.

Reg. 11 Closed Park (Parc Fermé)

After the Arrival Control, the motorbikes will stay in the Parc Fermé, until the last nation has passed by the Arrival Control and the final national hymn has been played. Participants may leave the Parc Fermé after this time.

Also at the end of the Nations Parade, the 28th of July 2017, a parking area will be created at the finish location in central of Sundsvall from 1:00 PM until 4:00 PM.

Reg. 13 Disqualifications

Participants shall be officially disqualified at the discretion of the Executive Committee if necessary.

Reg. 14 Prize Giving Ceremony

According to the FIM CTG (Rally Art. 25), this will take place on the evening of 28th of July. However, the FIM Meritum Junior and Inter-Clubs prizes will be awarded on the second evening (27th of July 2017)

Reg. 15 National Delegates

Each participating FNM has the right to nominate one delegate holder of a Tourism Steward's license. The nomination shall be made in writing to the Organiser at least 15 days before the event. (See Art. 18.7 – Instruction to the Organisers and participants of a FIM Classic Touristic Gathering Cat. A) See also Reg. 3.2 or the SR

Reg. 16 Cancellation of the Event

According to the CTG (Rally Art. 9), the Organiser can cancel the event:

- If, at the closing date, the numbers of entries is below 1000
- In case of absolute necessity

In the case of cancellation of the event, the participants who transmitted their entry forms before the closing entry date will be notified.

Reg. 17 General

Cancellation of registration

In case of individual registration cancelling, it shall be made by intermediary of the FNM of the participant and shall be transmitted to the Organiser at latest 31th of May 2017. In this case 90% of the registration fee will be refunded. 50% will be refunded if cancellation is between the 1th of June and the 30th of June 2017.

SR – The English version of this document is always determinative.

Reg. 18 Responsibility of the participants

According to the CTG (Rally Art.14) and Art.19 (Touristic Gatherings of Category A). Also participants have to respect local authority regulations and the Organisation "house-rules" during the event.

Reg. 19 Protection of the Environment

Participants of the FIM-Rally are motorcyclist ambassadors for their country and are expected to consider other road users (CTG Rally Art. 3)

Conform to Article 11.2 of the Environment Code – Rider Conduct:

Show respect on the roads

- Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users.
- Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding.
- Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding, remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits.

Noise annoyance

- Use standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.
- Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.

Environmental care

- Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding only on routes which are open to motorcyclists.
- Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- Encourages a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles.
